Psychometrist Stream

Professionals wishing to include psychometric Assessment as part of their professional practice can enroll in the Psychometrist Stream. With a minimum of a bachelors level degree required, this stream is open to human services professionals with psychometric assessment responsibilities who wish to access and utilize B-level Psychometric tools.

A Psychometrist is not licensed for independent practice and must work under a licensed psychologist. A Psychometric Technician focuses on the practical aspects of test administration and scoring, providing support to the psychologist in the assessment process.

Registered Psychologists Stream

Registered Psychologists who wish to expand their practice and refine their expertise. This stream requires a minimum of a Masters Degree and is open to both Provisional or fully Registered Psychologists with their Provincial Regulatory body.

A clinically trained assessment psychologist has a broader and more in-depth role which includes interpretation of assessment data within the context of psychological theory, making diagnosis, and formulating treatment plans.
