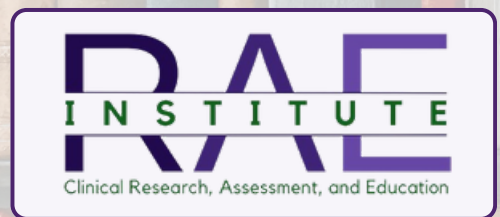

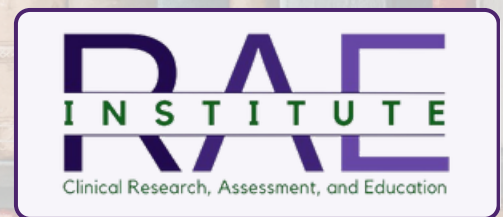

TO CLIENTS

Each course is available for **in-person or live online** participation. Each course is taught over 40 hours and the passing grade is 80%.

Only formal assessment courses from a recognized post-secondary institution will be considered for pre-requisite substitutes. Courses from other private or non-recognized programs, institutions or trainers will not be accepted. The Core Competencies courses, or equivalent foundational courses, will provide you with a fundamental understanding of the different types of assessments. However; additional theoretical and applied training in each specific type of assessment is necessary to ensure that you have the base competency to conduct each specific type of assessment.
